Sierra Mountain Music Camp Summer 2023

WHAT TO BRING! All belongings should be labeled with camper's first name and last initial.

The following is a check off list that may be helpful (please keep in mind yellow items are required)

Required:

- □ Sack lunch for first day! Our first meal together will be dinner on Sunday night.
- □ 1 set bed linens or sleeping bag, and pillow, extra blanket optional. (Camp provides bunk beds with a mattress. Each camper must bring their own sleeping equipment.)
- □ Duffel bag/suitcase -No paper or plastic bags except for dirty laundry! Camp has no drawers, lockers, etc.
- □ 1-2 gallon size Ziploc bags (to contain wet clothes, leaking toiletries, etc.)
- ☐ Garbage bag (for separating dirty laundry in your suitcase)
- □ Multiple pairs of sleeping clothes or pajamas. *Pajama Breakfast on Friday June 24th*
- □ 1 flashlight
- □ 2 pairs of casual shoes: tennis shoes, sandals or flats recommended camp is very DUSTY, flip flops are NOT recommended except as pool/shower shoes. Campers need a good clean pair of shoes for concert
- □ Daily shirts/t-shirts-6-7 min. We get dirty at camp. (see Rules Policy regarding the dress code for guidance. For example: No spaghetti straps, midriffs or inappropriate language)
- □ Undergarments & SOCKS
- ☐ Shorts-multiple pairs, it can be WARM at camp. (see Rules Policy regarding the dress code for guidance)
- Jeans/long pants. It gets cold a night plus the Night Hike Remember campers need a fresh pair of bottoms for the concert
- Sweatshirts or long sleeve shirts. Sweatshirts for SALE online before camp or at registration in limited quantities.
- □ A hat
- □ Sunglasses & sunscreen
- □ Bug repellent (lotion, cream or spray).
- □ Toiletries shampoo, conditioner, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, any personal hygiene items, skin care products, etc.
- □ Lip balm we get lots of chapped lips due the altitude.
- Beach towel and bath towels/wash cloths (please bring more than one, they get dirty and we do not provide any towels)
- Swim suit if you desire to participate in any of our water activities, including slip and slide.
- Any required medications These will be given to our Health Director on first day of camp.

Optional:

- □ Camera- Phones are not allowed at camp, no EXCEPTIONS!
- □ Costumes or crazy clothes (for skit night, talent show, crazy dinner, etc.)
- □ Throwback Thursday- Bring your old camp t shirts for some extra Thursday fun!
- □ White clothing item for *Tie Dye station* at arts and crafts.
- Any necessary item (instrument, music, sheet music, accessory, costumes, etc.) for talent night

Orchestra Campers ONLY:

- □ Instrument & instrument doubles
- □ Folding music stand, or portable stand. Campers will move these multiple times during the week.
- □ Extra strings, rosin, Fiddle Brite, polishing cloths & chin cloth or sponge.

WHAT NOT TO BRING!

- O NOT bring ANY electronic devices —cell phones, tablets, video games, laptop computers, radios All such items will be confiscated & held by the administrator until the END of camp. ONLY counselors may bring speakers, music devices, stereos for an approved activity. No music in cabins after 10 p.m. (We have NO cell service or internet at camp. We have a land line in the health station, should an emergency call need to be made.)
- O NOT bring shirts or other attire displaying explicit or suggestive messages or innuendoes of a sexual, political, religious, ethnic or controversial nature.
- O NOT bring midriff shirts, halter-tops, spaghetti strap tanks, short-shorts or micro skirts/dresses. Tank tops must have straps (at least 1 inch wide). Campers will be expected to change attire at staff request if attire is deemed inappropriate.
- O NOT bring/wear inappropriate, min coverage bikinis or swimming suits. Remember our camp is all ages and we want to respect that.
- ② **DO NOT bring anything irreplaceable -** expensive or sentimental jewelry, cameras, clothing, ect.
- O NOT bring knives, weapons, firearms, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco/ vape products of any kind. Any contraband found will be confiscated & the camper will be sent home forfeiting all camp fees.

MAIL:

Campers love to receive mail. You can write to your camper, just be sure to write early to avoid delay in delivery. In the left bottom corner, put the dates your camper will be in camp. **SMMC 2023-June 18th- June 24th**
